The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) acknowledges receipt of your correspondence dated May 5, 2017, expressing your concerns to the above applications. Your submission has been reviewed, and your concerns have been registered as a statement of concern (SOC), and assigned registration number 30721.

Your SOC is now being considered in the review of the applications. The SOC is now part of the public record of the applications and is available to the decision maker.

By way of copy of this letter to Granite Oil Corp., we are requesting they contact you to attempt to address your concerns, as provided under AER requirements.

The AER offers and strongly recommends you make use of our Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) program which features either staff or third party mediation arranged through an AER mediator. Please note that the AER has no jurisdiction over matters of compensation for land usage. The Alberta Surface Rights Board is the regulatory agency that deals with these issues. Further, the AER has no jurisdiction with respect to assessing the adequacy of Crown consultation associated with the rights of indigenous peoples.

Section 49 of the *Alberta Energy Regulator Rules of Practice* (Rules) requires that all documents filed with the AER be placed on the public record. However, any party may file a request for confidentiality of information under Section 49 prior to filing the information with the AER.
